

APPLICATION OF MODEL PROBLEM BASED LEARNING TO IMPROVE COOPERATION ATTITUDE AND RESULTS OF STUDENT LEARNING IN SOCIAL STUDIES MATERIAL THE STRUGGLE AGAINST THE INVADERS

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ABSTRACT

Title's of research "Application Of Model Problem Based Learning To Improve Cooperation Attitude And Results Of Student Learning In Social Studies Material The Struggle Against The Invaders". The background for the persistence of learning problem social studies particularly in the material the struggle against the invaders to improve cooperation attitude and results of student learning that on the show by students is still low. This is because they lack the skills of educators in selecting the models method and strategy from time don't develop so the impact on the value of this activity is still much under KKM.

The methods used are classroom action research adapting by Arikunto models which is conducted in two cycles every cycle consisting of several action including planning, implementation, observation, and reflection. In this case to build a sense of cooperation among students and improve learning outcomes research used a models Problem Based Learning.

Based on the background that the problem in this case is how to plan the implementation of the model Problem Based Learning can improve the attitude of cooperation and results of student learning in fifth-grade student.

As for the results of research using model Problem Based Learning in the first cycle shows the value of cooperation student attitudes that 81.2 and the percentage of student learning outcomes that meet the minimum completeness criteria (KKM) on the pre-test activities for 38.70 % and post-test activities for 41.93 %. In second cycles shows the value of cooperation student attitudes that 8.93 and the percentage of student learning outcomes that meet the minimum completeness criteria (KKM) on the pre-test activities for 74.19 % and post-test activities for 87,09%.

Based on the results of this observation concluded that Problem Based Learning models can improve the attitude of cooperation and student learning outcomes in learning social studies material the struggle against the invaders in fifth-grade student. SDN Cimincrang Bandung City, and can be used as an alternative learning models to be applied to KTSP learning.
