The end of the Cold War create to a single force that the United States which is the Super Power countries and countries that implement its hegemony in the entire region of the world, one area that will be trialled by the United States after the submission of Japan when it lost by the United States-led allies in World War II is countries of East Asia. Countries of East Asia is a potential country that will bring its own benefits for the United States. In the end the United States with its democratic opiate successfully applied the system of Democracy in East Asia countries including Japan, South Korea and Taiwan (anti-Communist Countries). But gait United States in East Asia is not as smooth as what is expected because of post-collapse of the Soviet Union there are still Communist countries in East Asia, namely China and North Korea because when the Cold War era China and North Korea are under the influence of the Soviet Union as a Communist state. For the United States and its allies is an impediment because it could be the countries of China and North Korea played its part to replace the position of United States forces in East Asia. Economic growth and military potential of China's great power and can not be denied that China will be key in East Asia.

In other case in East Asia is China's conflict with Taiwan is one of East Asia the territorial conflict that has lasted a long time. There are three actors involved in this conflict that is China, the United States and Taiwan. The conflict dates to the Chinese Communist Power trying to control China and the overthrow of national strength. The people who were knocked out in the end proclaimed a new country now called Taiwan. Because the policy of "One China Policy" Taiwan is part of China and the United States should not be associated with Taiwan's diplomatic than with China. While the benefits or usefulness of this research is theoretically useful research is expected to increase the repertoire of advancing the science of International Relations, especially regarding international relations, international politics and international policies.

The results of this research is the influence of United States relations with China against the United States selling weapons to Taiwan as well as the leitmotif of U.S. foreign policy in Taiwan that can benefit the U.S. as a pillar of State acting in the East Asian region, although there are still Chinese and North Korea as a barrier to U.S. Hegemony.
