

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine how much influence the knowledge, skills, work morale and performance of nurses influence. The research method used is descriptive and verification method. Descriptive methods in this study were used to find out how knowledge, skills, work morale and nurse performance. While the verification method in this study is used to test the truth of the hypothesis in order to determine the effect of work knowledge, skills, and morale on the performance of nurses at Melinda Hospital Bandung.

From this study, it is known that the results of multiple regression analysis show that there are influences between variables of knowledge, skills, and work morale on nurse performance which are systematically expressed by statistics. The results of multiple correlation analysis, the R value is included in the strong relationship between the variables of knowledge, skills, work morale and nurse performance. From the results of the analysis of the coefficient of determination, the magnitude of the influence of knowledge, skills and work morale on the performance of nurses is 63.9%, while the remaining 36.1% is influenced by other factors not examined by the author.
