

# **USE OF PROBLEM BASED LEARNING (PBL) MODEL TO IMPROVE LEARNING OUTCOMES OF STUDENTS IN CLASS IV SD IN COMMUNITY SUBTHEMES IN DIVERSITY**

(Classroom Action Research on Beautiful Theme 1 Material Togetherness in  
Subtheme 2 Class IV SDN Cigentur Banjaran District)

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## **ABSTRACT**

This study aims to improve student learning outcomes by using the Problem Based Learning model on the theme 1 Beautiful Togetherness subtheme 2 Togetherness in Diversity. This research was conducted in class IV SDN Cigentur, Banjaran District, Bandung Regency. The object of the research was class IV students with 39 students consisting of 20 men and 19 women. The design of this study uses the CAR model, which consists of III cycles, each cycle including the stages of planning, implementing actions, observing, and reflecting. The results of research for the Learning Implementation Plan (RPP) in the first cycle obtained results of 3.16 increased in the second cycle of 3.50 and increased in the third cycle of 3.83. On the learning outcomes of students obtained from the psychomotor aspects shows that in the first cycle students achieved mastery of psychomotor aspects (skills) by 44% increased in cycle II by 74% and increased in cycle III by 90%. In the learning outcomes of students obtained from the attitude of confidence in the first cycle reached a percentage of 51.3% increased in the second cycle of 73.3% and increased in the third cycle of 89.7%. In the learning outcomes of students obtained from the results of the pretest and posttest in the first cycle reached a percentage of 67%, in the second cycle which is an improvement from the results of the pretest and posttest in the first cycle increased by 79%, and in the third cycle which an improvement from the results of the pretest and posttest in the second cycle increased by a percentage of 90%. The conclusion obtained from this research is that the application of the Problem Based Learning model can improve the learning outcomes of grade IV students of SDN Cigentur, Banjaran District, Bandung Regency on the theme of learning 1 Beautifulness of Subtheme 2 Togetherness in Diversity.
