

THE EFFECT OF TEACHER PERFORMANCE ON STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

(Quantitative Research on Teachers and Students in Elementary Schools in Citereup Village, Dayeuh Kolot Sub District, Bandung District)

ABSTRAK

This study aims to determine the effect of teacher performance on student learning outcomes. This research was conducted at SDN in Citereup Village, Dayeuh Kolot Sub District, Bandung District. This research is motivated by the fact that there are still student learning outcomes that have not yet reached the minimum learning criteria and there are teachers who are still lack than optimal in the preparation of lesson plans, implementing on learning, and do the evaluation. In this study, the researchers used an instrument such as a documentation to collect student learning outcomes in the form of daily scores for students of theme 1 in the 2019-2020 school year and questionnaire sheets which is used to retrieve data related to teacher performance. The results showed that 26 teachers were in the high performance category, 46 teachers were in the low performance category. In addition, there were also 69 students who passed the learning outcomes and 3 students who had not passed the learning outcomes. The results of calculations in this study using simple linear regression analysis that obtained a significance value of 0.001 with a probability value of 0.05. From this value it can be seen that $0.001 < 0.05$ therefore it can be concluded that there is an effect of teacher performance on student learning outcomes in all elementary school in the Citereup Village, Dayeuh Kolot Sub District, Bandung District.
