## **ABSTRACT**

**Agni Rizkisyaidi Permana** (2019). Implementation Of Green Constitution Policies In Maintaining Green Open Spaces (Gos).

West Bandung is one of the regencies in Indonesia that experiences dynamic development every time. The development directly or indirectly affects green open space which should be used according to the needs of West Bandung regency because basically every region is required to provide green open space in its area as much as 30 percent. For this reason, this research was conducted to determine the implementation of green constitution policies in maintaining green open space (GOS). This study uses a qualitative approach and and descriptive study methods. Data collection is done by interview, observation, documentation and literature studies. The findings of this study are: (1) West Bandung Regency has 26 green open spaces (GOS) with a total area of 244,685 M2. (2) policies issued by the West Bamdung Regency Government do not all take the form of written regulations, or Regional Regulations but include appeals, and orders. (3) With the presence of green space, rain water will quickly seep into the ground which makes sufficient water reserves in the soil. However, with a little green space will make water difficult to seep into the ground, then there will be floods and landslides during the rainy season, and during the dry season the water in the ground will be exhausted which makes drought. (4) The area of green space is only 17% of the total area of West Bandung regency, so that going to 30% takes a long time due to budget and land issues that are difficult to obtain, besides non-technical budget issues such as human resources and public awareness are other obstacles. The solution is that the unused land is used by rejuvenating the green space, the community must be given a special socialization to protect the green space by not littering and selling in the green space, and in collaboration with other parties to obtain additional funds, for example grants from other countries as obtained Bandung City Government.
