SCHOOL PARTICIPATION RATE AGE 16-18 YEARS OLD OF RELATION ON POVERTY LEVEL IN WEST JAVA

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ABSTRACT

This research aimed to determine: (i) a description of the School Participation Rate age 16-18 years old in West Java (ii) a description of the Poverty Level in West Java (iii) how much influence of School Participation Rate has on the Poverty Level in West Java. The method used is a survey with a quantitative approach on 27 districts and cities sample in West Java. The data collection technique in this research uses a form of documentation study and the data processing technique is carried out by using the help of SPSS Statistics Version 24.0 for Windows. The hypothesis in this research reads that "There is an influence of the School Participation Rate age 16-18 years old (X) on the poverty level (Y) in West Java. The results showed: (i) the school participation rate age 16-18 years old in West Java has 69.05% with the "high" category, (ii) the poverty level in West Java has 3.07% with the "low" category, (iii) school participation rate age 16-18 years old of relation on poverty level in West Java amounted 0.401 or 40.1% and amounted 59.9% showed by other factors. The author suggests to the related parties, namely: (i) the institution is expected to be able to increase trust, show good performance, and convey relevant and reliable information to the public, especially those who need data (ii) for further researchers have to add other variables that did not found on this research by adding the research period to produced the conclusions that have a broad scope.
