## VERBAL INFLUENCE OF BULLYING AGAINST THE INTERPERSONAL INTELLIGENCE OF CLASS V ELEMENTARY STUDENTS IN THE VILLAGE OF BABAKAN CIPARAY BANDUNG

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## **ABSTRACT**

Personal intelligence can be influenced by several factors, one of which is environmental factors. Frequent verbal bullying in the school environment can indirectly make the school environment less good for the development of students' interpersonal intelligence. This research aims to find out how the effect of verbal bullying that occurs on interpersonal intelligence that students in grade V of Babakan Ciparay Village Elementary School in Bandung. This research is a quantitative study that uses survey methods. The research was conducted in six public elementary schools in Babakan Ciparay Village, Bandung. Instruments used in the form of likert scale questionnaires. Research techniques use interviews and questionnaires. The population of this study was 643 students, sampling techniques using Simple Random Sampling so that a sample of 247 students in grade V elementary school. This research data analysis technique uses a simple linear regression test. Based on the results of research conducted in six public elementary schools in Babakan Ciparay Village, Bandung found that there is a positive influence between verbal bullying and interpersonal intelligence, this can be proven based on nilai  $F_{hitumg}$ = 39.982 with a significance of 0.000 having a smaller value (<) than the value of 0.05. As for the influence exerted from verbal acts of bullying on the interpersonal intelligence of grade V students of SD Babakan Ciparay Village, Bandung by 14%. This is indicated based on the determination coefficient value (RSquare) of 0.140. Based on the results of the study,  $H_1$  research is acceptable, namely there is an influence between verbal bullying on interpersonal intelligence. In general, verbal bullying is common among the public, including children. However, it is better if we always pay attention to the development of children in the school environment, so as not to be perpetrators or victims in verbal acts of bullying. In addition, we need to always pay attention to the development of interpersonal intelligence in order to continue to develop properly.
