

ABSTRACT

FACTORS THAT AFFECT STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES IN ECONOMIC SUBJECTS

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The purpose of this research to find out: 1) what factors affect student learning outcomes. 2) what are the most dominant factors affecting student learning outcomes in economic subjects. The research method used is literature study. The results of this study state that: 1) there are several factors that affect student learning outcomes including: internal factors and external factors. Internal factors, namely Psychological Factors (Learning Independence, Learning Interest, Learning Motivation, Learning Readiness) Physiological Factors (physical and health) and External Factors namely School Environmental Factors (Learning Facilities, Learning Methods, Learning Media, School Time) Family Environmental Factors (Attention Parents, Family Economic Conditions). Community Environmental Factors (Friends). 2) The factors that most dominantly affect student learning outcomes in economic subjects from internal factors are the factors of learning motivation, learning styles and interest in learning. while the external factors are family environmental factors and school environmental factors. The author suggests to related parties, namely 1) for teachers, it is hoped that teachers can guide and make more approaches to students, 2) for students, it is hoped that students will be even more enthusiastic in the learning process in order to get better learning outcomes, 3) for schools, it is expected provide or improve school facilities in support of the teaching and learning process 4) For further research, it is hoped that it can become a reference for similar research material but other facts, ideas, discussions and different points of view.
