ANALYSIS OF INITIAL LEARNING AND ACQUISITION IN THE PANDEMIC SITUATION OF CORONA VIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) AT SMA NASIONAL BANDUNG

(Survey Conducted on Class X Students of Bandung National High School)

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to find out how learning craftsmanship and entrepreneurship in the Covid-19 pandemic situation, knowing how the barriers and advantages of learning craftsmanship and entrepreneurship in the Covid-19 pandemic situation, and knowing how students' efforts to overcome the obstacles of the Covid-19 Pandemic in class X SMA Nasional Bandung. The problem in this study is that learning carried out online has made it difficult for some students, this happened because of the Covid-19 pandemic. The method used in this research is descriptive quantitative method with surveys as data collection tools supported by interviews and literature study as data comparison. Based on the results of the analysis using the help of the SPSS 26 application, the results obtained were 100% valid. All questions were declared reliable with a value of 0.748. The results of the study in this study explained that (1) learning at school was carried out online, the results of the survey that had been carried out showed the average value obtained from the total frequency and weighted score of 3.73 from the highest score of 5 with a percentage of 75% which means that learning is categorized as good. (2) learning constraints experienced by students such as weak signal constraints, unfavorable household conditions, unsupportive learning equipment and fast-running quota. Apart from obstacles, online learning also has advantages such as flexible and practical time, interesting craft materials because there are lots of pictures, and online learning also fosters learning independence. (3) the efforts of students in overcoming learning difficulties such as preparing cellphones, wps office applications, looking for free wifi and the last alternative is to collect assignments via WhatsApp if edulogy cannot. During this pandemic, schools should always prioritize health protocols during learning activities and teachers always play an active role in responding to learning difficulties experienced by students. In addition, students are also taught by situations to be more patient and dynamic human beings with accelerated changes so that learning in the midst of this pandemic can be a reflection of becoming a better person.
