

THE EFFECT OF INDUSTRIAL WORK PRACTICES ON STUDENT WORK READINESS

(Survey on Class XII Accounting and Financial Institution Skill Competence in SMK

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine: (i) the implementation of the Industrial Work Practice (Prakerin) for students of class XII students of Accounting and Financial Institution Skills Competence in SMK Pasundan 1 Bandung City for the Academic Year 2021/2022, (ii) work readiness of class XII students of Accounting and Finance Institution in SMK Pasundan 1 Bandung City for the Academic Year 2021/2022, (iii) the influence of the Industrial Work Practice (Prakerin) on the work readiness of class XII students of Accounting and Financial Institution in SMK Pasundan 1 Bandung City for the Academic Year 2021/2022. The research method used is a survey method with a mixed approach. The data collection technique used a questionnaire instrument with descriptive statistical data analysis techniques. The results showed that: (i) the implementation of the Industrial Work Practice (Prakerin) showed very good results with a score of 4.29, (ii) students work readiness showed very good results with a score of 4.49, and (iii) the influence of the Industrial Work Practice (Prakerin) on the student work readiness amounted to 0.716 or 71.6%. The hypothesis proposed in this study are proving that "there is an effect of Industrial Work Practice (Prakerin) on work readiness". The author suggests to: (i) students are expected to take Industrial Work Practices (Prakerin) seriously, (ii) teachers are expected to improve guidance and monitoring to students while carrying out Industrial Work Practices (Prakerin) (iii) for schools are expected to improve things that support Industrial Work Practices (Prakerin), (iii) future researchers are expected to need to study more deeply about references and prepare themselves better when collecting data.
