AN ABSTRACT

The purpose of this reseach was to determine: (i) how the social economic status of the family, (ii) how the students interest in continuing their education to college, (iii) how much influence the social economic status of the family has on the students interest in continuing their education to college in class XII IPS SMA Negeri 1 Ciwidey. The research uses a quantitative approach with 138 sampel of students. The results showed: (i) social economic status of the family it is included in the sufficient category, the result is that with an average score of 3.15; (ii) students interest in continuing their education to college, the result is that with an average score of 4.10 it is included in the sufficient category; (iii) influence the social economic status of the family has on the students interest in continuing their education to college, which is 53% with the interpretation criteria are quite strong.
