LEARNING TO PRODUCE MODERN POETRY TEXT USING ZINE MEDIA FOR 8TH GRADE STUDENTS OF MTS AR-ROHMAH BANDUNG ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

ABSTRACT

This research is motivated by the declining effectiveness of learning since the implementation of the online mode PJJ system during the Covid-19 pandemic, the low skills of students in producing modern poetry texts, and the Zine media with the spirit of Do It Yourself that has never been used by Indonesian language teachers in formal classes. Some of these things are caused by the limited creativity of teachers in providing learning media, offering a conducive two-way interaction in the midst of virtual face-to-face learning, and Zine has not been widely used in formal classes, especially in Indonesian subjects. As a result, students find it difficult to understand the missing material, the creative process, and enthusiasm for learning creative literature in the classroom. Therefore, the writer uses Zine as an alternative medium to produce modern poetry texts in the classroom. This study aims to describe the ability of 8th graders in producing modern poetry texts based on the types and elements of poetry building. In addition, to test the effectiveness of using Zine media in learning to produce modern poetry texts compared to picture card media in the control class. The research method that the author uses is a quasiexperimental method with the nonequivalent control group category. The subjects of this study were 8th grade students of MTs Ar-Rohmah Bandung. The results of the research that the authors obtained prove that the authors are able to carry out learning to produce modern poetry texts using Zine media. Students are able to produce modern poetry texts using Zine media. This can be seen from the average pre-test score of the experimental class from 59 to 77 at the post-test (an increase of 18%). Media Zine proved effective by referring to the results of the paired sample t test which showed that Sig. (2-tailed) of 0.000 is less than the probability of 0.05. There is a significant difference in learning outcomes between the experimental class using Zine media and the control class using picture card media. This can be seen through the results of the Mann-Whitney test which shows that the Asymp value. Sig. (2-tailed) of 0.021 is less than the probability of 0.05. Thus, it can be concluded that the Zine media is effective and proven to be significant in improving the ability to produce modern poetry texts for 8th grade students at MTs Ar-Rohmah Bandung.
