

ABSTRACT

This study observes a regional environmental policy called the Eco-Innovation Action Plan which is one of the policies that move towards environmental issues in the European Union. The author uses one of the member countries of the European Union, namely Luxembourg as a sample of member countries that implement the regional policy and identifies the level of effectiveness of Luxembourg's implementation of the Eco-Innovation Action Plan policy.

The institutionalist liberalism approach used in this study, looks at the European Union actor who launched an international environmental regime called the Eco-Innovation Action Plan. Responses to environmental problems focus on the implementation and development of international environmental regimes.

In this study it was found that the Eco-Innovation Action Plan had a good impact on Luxembourg by launching the national policy of PNEC and the national body of LuxInnovation under the auspices of the EcoAP policy.

GGGI shows that green growth in Luxembourg has consistently increased in the 2016-2019 period, starting with a score of 66.66 in 2016 and a score of 67.34 in 2019.
