

***ANALYSIS OF CHARACTER MORALITY IN SI KABAYAN FOLKLORE
COLLECTION AS AN ALTERNATIVE TEACHING MATERIAL FOR
DELIVERING MESSAGES IN FICTION BOOKS IN HIGH SCHOOL***

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ABSTRACT

This study contains the results of the analysis of the morality of the characters in the collection of Si Kabayan folklore as alternative teaching materials to convey messages in fiction books in high school. The purpose of this study was to determine the results of the analysis related to the problem of character morality, the messages contained in the analysis results and their usefulness as teaching materials that can be used by class XI students. The research method used is a qualitative approach. The type of approach used is descriptive qualitative so that researchers can describe the research clearly, systematically and completely. The form of research used is content analysis, which means that it leads to drawing conclusions about a factual phenomenon. The source of data in this study is a collection of folklore Si Kabayan by Achdiat K. Mihardja. The data collection procedure used observation, interviews, documentation, triangulation techniques and data analysis. The conclusion from the results of this study (1) There are 61 data from the analysis of 28 titles of folklore. This study shows that there are 7 data for heteronomous morality, while 54 data for autonomous morality. This proves that the collection of folklore "Si Kabayan" contains more moral actions that come from personal will, not on the basis of coercion from other parties. (2) From the results of the analysis obtained 61 messages contained in each title of folklore. The description of the message conveyed by the researcher is in the form of a mandate, either express or implied. (3) The data on the analysis of the morality of the characters in the collection of folklore Si Kabayan by Achdiat K. Mihardja can be used as Indonesian language teaching materials because they contain KD. 3.11 analyze messages in fiction books read.
