

**THE INFLUENCE OF PARENTS' PARENTING ON THE LEARNING
MOTIVATION OF GRADE 5 STUDENTS DURING ONLINE
LEARNING AT SD DARUL HIKAM 2 RANCAEKEK**

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ABSTRACT

This research was motivated by the low motivation to learn grade 5 students of SD Darul Hikam 2 Rancaekek due to the change in the learning system during the Covid-19 pandemic to online learning. The purpose of this study was to determine the influence of parental parenting patterns on the learning motivation of grade 5 students during online learning at SD Darul Hikam 2 Rancaekek for the 2022/2023 school year. The research uses a quantitative type of research with descriptive analysis, the method uses a survey with a cross-sectional survey design. Data processing is assisted by IBM SPSS Statistics 16 and Microsoft Excel 2010 software. The results showed that parenting at the time of online learning, namely democratic parenting, had an average of 3.59 with a percentage of 89.7%. There was an increase in student learning motivation under parental care during online learning by 0.170 with a percentage of 17%.
