ANALYSIS OF TYPES OF MEANING IN THE COLLECTION SHORT STORY "ORANG-ORANG BLOOMINGTON" BY BUDI DARMA AS ALTERNATIVE INDONESIAN TEACHING MATERIALS FOR CLASS X SMA

ABSTRACT

This research was motivated by the finding of students' difficulties in finding meaning in short stories. The short story used is entitled "Orang-Orang Bloomington" by Budi Darma. This study aims to develop teaching materials as an alternative in learning Indonesian in high school. This study uses a descriptive qualitative method. The research sources used in this research are short stories entitled: "Orang-Orang Bloomington" by Budi Darma and 7 short stories were selected as samples. Data collection techniques through literature review, documentation, and analysis. The results showed that all connotative meanings, denotative meanings, grammatical meanings, lexical meanings, figurative meanings, straightforward meanings, referential meanings, non-referential meanings, general meanings, special meanings, changes in word meanings, shifts in word meanings, and word meaning relationships can be selected as Indonesian language teaching materials in high school. This is supported by data from the research results of all types of meaning contained in the collection of short stories "Orang-Orang Bloomington" by Budi Darma which have the following percentages: connotative meaning 7.49%, denotative meaning 10.7%, grammatical meaning 11.3%, lexical meaning 11%, figurative meaning 5.19%, straightforward meaning 10.8%, referential meaning 10.8%, non-referential meaning 10.5%, general meaning 7.49%, special meaning 7.34%, changes in word meaning 3.21%, the shift in the meaning of the word 1.98%, and the relationship meaning of the word 1.98%. Based on the results of the validation of material experts and Indonesian language learning, it shows that the modules compiled can be used as teaching materials. This is supported by the validation results in terms of material assessment getting an average value of 88, in terms of presentation assessment getting an average value of 88.5, and in terms of language getting an average value of 90.5. Thus, the results of research on the types of word meanings in the collection of short stories "Orang-Orang Bloomington" by Budi Darma can be used as teaching materials in class X SMA.
