

ABSTRACT

The agricultural sector has an important role in building the national economy including the regional economy, because the regional agricultural sector functions as one of the country's development tools. To find out clove farmers in Sukamulya sub-district, Cibeber sub-district, Lebak district, Banten. The purpose of this study was to determine the characteristics and influence of land area (LL), total production (JP), labor (TK) on clove income (PC) in Sukamulya village, Cibeber sub-district, Lebak district, Banten. This research was conducted on 68 clove farmers in Sukamulya Village, Cibeber District, Lebak Regency, Banten. The income of clove farmers in Sukamulya District, Cibeber District, Lebak Regency, Banten has not changed for the last three years. The results showed that the variable land area (LL) had a positive and significant effect on clove income (PC), Total Production (JP) had a negative and significant effect on clove income, Labor (TK) had a negative and significant effect on clove income. clove income. The simultaneous influence of land area, amount of production, and labor contributed 65.2% to clove farmers' income and the remaining 34.8% was influenced by other variables. Meanwhile, partially, the area of land, the amount of production, and the workforce have an effect on the income of clove farmers in Sukamulya District, Cibeber District, Lebak Regency, Banten.
