ABSTRACT

This research is entitled "Self-Concept of Children Out of Contract Marriages (Qualitative Descriptive Study of Self-Concept of Adolescents Out of Contract Marriages in the Cisarua-Puncak Area of Cianjur Regency). This study explores the phenomenon of contract marriages in the Cisarua-Puncak area so that it has an impact on the self-concept of children resulting from contract marriages.

This study also uses a phenomenological approach as a human form that constructs important meanings and concepts within the framework of intersubjectivity, that is, adolescents' self-concept understanding of the world and its surroundings is shaped by their relationships with other people, although the meaning created can be traced in actions, works and activities carried out, there are still other people's roles in it. The constructivism paradigm is also used to determine individual interpretations, views, and responses to the self-concept that is formed.

The process of collecting data through library research and field studies is described by the author so that motives, actions, and self-concept meanings in adolescents as children of contract marriages can be identified because of the environment built on their relationships with the people around them. influenced by parenting style. lacking so that the form of self-confidence also affects his views on other people.

In this study I suggest that in forming self-concept it is necessary to be aware of oneself and others because this will affect the personality experiences of each individual which will shape him/herself to be good. This research is also expected to provide information and knowledge for the community about the phenomenon of contact marriage and self-concept.
