

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the magnitude of the influence of the government's internal control system and the performance of local government officials on the implementation of good government governance in the SKPD of the Purwakarta Regency government.

The method used in this study is a survey method with a descriptive and verification approach using primary data. The sample in this study was 108 respondents with data sources obtained through the results of distributing questionnaires to 30 Regional Work Units (SKPD) in the Purwakarta Regency government. The sampling technique used is saturated/census sampling. The statistical analysis used in this study is multiple regression analysis, multiple correlation, hypothesis testing using partial tests and simultaneous tests as well as analysis of the coefficient of determination with the help of using SPSS IBM Statistics 26 software.

Based on the results of the research conducted, it can be seen that partially the government's internal control system influences the implementation of good government governance, while the performance of local government officials influences the implementation of good government governance. Where the magnitude of the influence of the government's internal control system is 45.1% and the performance of local government apparatus is 30.0% on the implementation of good government governance. Simultaneously the government's internal control system and the performance of local government apparatus on the implementation of good government governance is 75.1%, while the remaining 24.9% is the influence of factors outside the two independent variables being studied.
