## **ABSTRACT**

Indonesia as a developing country, it is difficult for Indonesia to survive amid the swift flow of globalization in order to build a country that continues to grow rapidly. With these conditions, Indonesia tries to open itself up by establishing cooperation between other countries for the implementation of economic development. This study aims to determine the effect of Foreign Debt, Foreign Investment and Total Labor on Indonesia's Economic Growth. This study uses quantitative methods with secondary data, and the number of research samples is 25 years (1996-2020). The results of the Foreign Debt variable show a negative but insignificant effect on Indonesia's Economic Growth. The results of the Foreign Investment variable show a positive and significant effect on Indonesia's Economic Growth. The results of the Total Labor variable show a positive but insignificant effect on Indonesia's Economic Growth.
