

ABSTRACT

This study discusses the WTO decision in the Indonesia-Brazil trade dispute related to the import of chicken. Indonesia is considered to have enacted regulations for the import of poultry products which impede the trade process and violated several agreements written in the World Trade Organization. In this study the authors used a qualitative descriptive method by trying to explain how the WTO decision affected the trade balance between Indonesia and Brazil.

Where this method emphasizes the analysis of a problem that applies in society that is happening and the effects caused by a phenomenon.
