

ABSTRACT

Metaphor is one figurative language that has a very important role in human life, especially in literature such as novels and poetry or song lyrics. The songwriter usually uses metaphors in lyrics so that the lyrics are more beautiful and unique. The purpose of this research is to analyze metaphors in Oddinary Album by Stray Kids. This research analyzes the types of metaphors and finds out what the dominant type of metaphor that used in the song lyrics and to convey what are the meaning of metaphor in Oddinary album by Stray Kids. According to Lakoff and Johnson (1980), metaphorical expressions in language represent underlying logical metaphors, with the metaphor problem-solving serving as the means of expression. Our everyday conceptual system, through which we behave and think, is essentially metaphorical in nature. This research project utilizes a descriptive qualitative approach. Data analysis and conclusions will provide answers to the research's questions. The theory of George Lakoff and Mark Johnson is used to examine the idea of metaphorical expression. There are structural metaphors, orientational metaphors, and ontological metaphors. The results of this research show that all types of metaphors are found in the Oddinary album by Stray Kids. There are 35 conceptual metaphors including 7 structural metaphors, 10 orientational metaphors, and 18 ontological metaphors found in the data. "Ontological metaphors" are the most commonly utilized conceptual metaphors in the data. The meaning of metaphors that appeared in the data referred to every normal person, especially ourselves, as something "odd" or uncommon, and what is "odd" will soon become ordinary. The songwriters also write about a journey of love, toxic relationships, loneliness, and self-improvement
