The word animation comes from the Latin anima, which means life, or animate, which means blowing spirits or life into inanimate objects; then, the term is translated into English into animate, which means giving life (to give life to), or animation, which means the illusion of movement. The term animation is defined as making cartoons (the making of cartoons), but in Indonesian, it is called animation. (Ranang, 2010: 9)

Animated films are films that are usually given to children. The animation provides many life messages with a storyboard made as simple as possible so that children can understand what messages they get from the animation. Animation also displays striking colors and imaginative shapes that can train children's imagination so that children become creative and also understand the message being conveyed. In every animated film, there

will certainly be characters who bring the entire contents of the story is conveyed.

Character is one of the important elements in a movie. Characters are made to distinguish one entity from another (humans, animals, spirits, robots, furniture, and other objects) based on mental, emotional, and social qualities. Character is a value that reflects the charm of the place where problems and events are based so that the story is built. Characters in a film play a very important role. Without characters, there is no story, and there is no plot. At the same time, the dissimilarity of characters will give birth to shifts, conflicts of interest, and conflicts that eventually give birth to stories. A film has a variety of characters who complement each other to provide conflict, plot, and story development, as the storyteller desires. Although in its development, many films only show one or two characters throughout the duration. Characters are usually created with special traits and qualities.

Character is not only in the form of character recognition through age, physical form, appearance, costume, tempo, or rhythm of the character's play but also the character's inner attitude. Each character in a film is always closely related to other characters. The process of giving character to a character is called characterization. Characterization is an attempt to display the character or character of the character being played. Characterization is a description of the characters in the story. It can be about physical images (gender, face, eyes, hair, clothes, age, how to walk, and so on. It can also be psychological and emotional images (behaviour,

sadness, anger, etc.). In films, characterization is one of the elements. Important. According to Dewojati (2010:169), the element of characterization in drama, usually called the character, is the most active ingredient to move the plot. The writer can reveal the logical reasons for the character's behaviour through this characterization.

In this paper, the writer wants to research an Animation Movie entitled Barbie, a Fashion Fairytale. Barbie, a Fashion Fairytale, is an animated movie in the fantasy genre and girly theme by Elise Allen based on Barbie's doll as the characters. Barbie was a legendary movie that every child in the world watched in child time. Barbie has many fans among children or teenagers because of her fashionable trend and iconic pinkthemed. Barbie, a Fashion Fairytale, is a sequel to Barbie Universe; several types of Barbie movies have different themes and characters. Barbie's movie has a story based on real life with the add-on of fantasy spice to make it more interesting to watch.

Barbie has a simple story that always happened in humans' social life. The problem, the characters, and the story are simple but full of moral messages. The characters are made with various looks and kinds. In Tesa Helly Rondowunu research, it focuses on characterization analyzes the characterization of the main character Odette, which are kind, brave, firm, modest, and polite.

The similarity between this research and Tesa Helly Rondowunu research is both analyze about the characterization of the main character and what factors that influence the characterization development of the main character. The difference between this research and Tesa Helly Rondowunu's research are the object. The object in this study has a heavier weight due to a more complicated story and also more characters. Tesa Helly Rondowunu's research uses the main character Odette in Barbie of

Swan Movie, while this research uses the main character Barbie in Barbie a Fashion Fairytale movie by Elise Allen.

Based on this background, the writer is interested in conducting research or analysing the main character, Barbara Millicent Roberts, in the animated film "Barbie: A Fashion Fairytale."
