Abstract

This research focuses on the issue of sexism in the series "The Queen's Gambit" experienced by Elizabeth Harmon as the main character. This series represents how society, family, rivals and even friends discriminated against women in the world of chess in the 1950s and 1960s. The goal of the study is to examine the type of sexism that Beth experienced during her process of becoming a professional chess player. As the results of this study, the researcher summarised that Beth experiences both types of sexism; Hostile and Benevolent. Hostile sexism appears in almost every episode and benevolent sexism present in several key interactions across the series. The sexist behaviour she received made her feel insecure and led her to alcohol and drugs to escape from the pressure. Charles Sanders Pierce's semiotic theory (1914) is used in this research to analyse the sexist behaviour in the series. Based on the object of the study this research employed qualitative descriptive method. The findings show that from 7 episodes, 25 data were found in the form of scenes categorized as signs. The 11 data were classified as hostile sexism and 7 were classified as benevolent sexism while 8 other scenes were categorized as the impact of sexist behaviour. For this reason, hostile sexism is considered as the most common sexist behaviour that Beth experiences.
