ABSTRACT

This research aims to determine the influence of Tax Knowledge, Tax Sanctions, and

Financial Conditions on Taxpayer Compliance of E-Commerce Sellers at Shopee. The independent

variables in this research are Tax Knowledge, Tax Sanctions, and Financial Condition. Meanwhile,

the dependent variable in this research is Taxpayer Compliance.

The population of this research is E-Commerce Sellers in the fashion with category top for

women's fashion who live in Bandung City with a sample size of 39 respondents. This research is

quantitative research with a descriptive and verification approach. This research uses primary data

obtained through distributing questionnaires via Google Form. Verification analysis in this

research is in the form of a t test, simple regression test, correlation coefficient test, and

determination coefficient test. To test each variable the SPSS application will be used Statistics

version 29.

Based on the results of research conducted on E-Commerce Sellers at Shopee, it is known

that Tax Knowledge has a positive effect on Taxpayer Compliance and has the ability to explain

Taxpayer Compliance of 42.0%. Tax sanctions have a positive effect on Taxpayer Compliance and

have the ability to explain Taxpayer Compliance of 45.0%. Financial Conditions have a positive

effect on Taxpayer Compliance and have the ability to explain Taxpayer Compliance of 50.7%.
