ABSTRACT

This research is aimed at determining the performance of implementation of village infrastructure development in Bunijaya village, Gununghalu District, West Bandung Regency. Focusing on the implementation performance of village infrastructure development carried out by the Bunijaya Village government office, Gununghalu sub-district, West Bandung regency. Using the Kapioru implementation performance theory approach which has four indicators, namely environmental conditions, inter-organizational relationships, resources and the character of the implementing institution. The conclusions of this research are expected to provide insight for the Bandung Regency Land Office in improving the implementation of the PTSL program to be more effective and efficient in providing services to the community and ensuring the fulfillment of land ownership rights fairly and evenly.
