ABSTRACT

This research is entitled Communication Patterns of Children to Parents (In Maintaining Parents' Trust and Hope in Overseas Students at Pasundan University). Communication patterns are a way of showing a process of conveying statements carried out by two or more people. It is proven that this form of activity is carried out by parents and children among overseas students.

Furthermore, the aim of conducting this research is to determine the forms of efforts made by overseas students to maintain the trust and hopes of their parents, based on the interpersonal communication components according to Devito. including openness, empathy, support, positive feelings, and equality

The method used in this research is qualitative with a descriptive approach. Data obtained through direct interviews, library observations, electronic books, internet, documentation. Researchers determined 7 core informants, 7 supporting informants and 1 academic informant. The theory used by researchers to research this is the Consensual Communication Pattern, where family type communication has a high level of conversation and conformity and obedience and creates harmony in the family, and the Laissez Faire Communication Pattern, where this family type communication pattern is low in conversation and suitability

The results of the research show that overseas students' efforts to maintain the trust and hopes of their parents are more dominant in the consensual communication theory where the level of communication carried out is quite high and prioritizes parental direction in order to realize their parents' hopes. So the researchers concluded that, based on interviews with informants, in maintaining parents' trust and hopes, good, effective, harmonious communication and prioritizing honesty are needed.
