**ABSTRACT** 

This study aims to analyze the elements of romance in Jenny Han's novel P.S. I

Still Love You using the romance formula theory by Neal Wyatt and Joyce G.

Saricks. The method used in this study is descriptive qualitative, with data analysis

techniques in the form of selection process data, data presentation, and explaining

conclusions. Data were taken from the novel text analyzed based on the theory of

romance formula. The results of the study show that the novel P.S. I Still Love You
