#### **Abstract**

By drawing on previous studies that examine diction and figurative language, this paper aims to provide a structured framework for analyzing how word choices influence meaning and evoke emotions in poetry. The findings highlight the significance of diction in shaping the reader's experience and understanding of the unapologetic feelings expressed in Bohang's poetry, ultimately contributing to the broader discourse on poetic analysis and emotional expression in literature.
