

ABSTRACT

Neng Delisa (2026), *Self-Resilience Amid the Current of Globalization: Generation Z Students' Perceptions of Their Understanding of Pancasila Education (A Descriptive Study at SMAN 1 Margaasih)*.

This study was motivated by the rapid development of globalization, which affects the mindset, behavior, and social life of Generation Z students, particularly through the advancement of digital technology, the internet, and social media. The increasingly rapid flow of globalization provides positive impacts, such as easier access to information and communication, but also presents challenges, including declining social awareness, low levels of tolerance, individualistic behavior, and the influence of foreign cultures that are not always aligned with Pancasila values. These conditions pose challenges to students' character building and self-resilience; therefore, Pancasila Education is considered to play an important role in guiding students to respond to the influence of globalization critically, wisely, and responsibly. This study aims to describe Grade XI students' understanding of Pancasila values, their perceptions of the role of Pancasila Education in developing self-resilience, and the implementation of Pancasila values in daily life at SMAN 1 Margaasih. This study employed a qualitative approach with a descriptive method. The research informants consisted of twelve Grade XI students, three Pancasila Education teachers, one Vice Principal for Curriculum Affairs, and one Principal. Data collection techniques were conducted through observation, interviews, and documentation studies, which were then analyzed using the Miles and Huberman model. The results of the study indicate that students' understanding of Pancasila values varies, ranging from conceptual understanding to practical implementation in daily life. Pancasila Education is considered to play a role in helping students respond more wisely to technological developments, social media, and social environments. The implementation of Pancasila values is reflected in attitudes of tolerance, cooperation, discipline, responsibility, and positive social relationships, although their application has not been fully consistent due to the influence of the social environment, technological developments, and globalization.
